- **Travel Plan**

Students are instructed to send their travel plan to Chief Warden and the respective Hostel Wardens. This information should reach in advance through email at registrar@iisuniv.ac.in to allow arrangements at IISU for screening on arrival. The following details should be shared:

- Student contact details and email ID
- Mode of Travel
- City of Departure
- Date and time of Arrival at Jaipur
- Consent form duly signed by the parent/guardian
- **All students prior to reporting at the hostel should submit RTPCR negative certificate (taken within 72 hours).**
- **All those who do not bring the aforesaid certificate will not be given entry in the hostel, which please note.**
- Hostellers having fever will not be allowed to enter the hostel
- The students will not be given weekly and monthly outings so they are required to bring all requisite items of personal use in stock.
